Save some money with TLC - our top tips for using LESS printer ink

We love you buying printer ink from us and know that it is a big expense for a lot of you, so we've done some research and thought we'd give you some tips on how to use less:

Do you really need to print that document - It might sound obvious but if it's a proof, or a non essential document could you read it on screen instead? Think about what you really NEED to print and ask your staff to do the same.

Does it NEED to be in colour? - Who is this document for? If it is for internal use rather than for a client, do you really need it in true photorealistic colour? Try

choosing to print in greyscale if you can.

Only print the part of the document you need - If you're printing off a webpage it is tempting to print the whole thing, including the images and background design. Do you really need all that? Whenever you print a webpage you have the option to choose which part of the page you print, you could even copy and paste the text if that is what is really important.

Buy Compatible cartridges - There are many very high quality compatible cartridges out there. You don't need to spend the extra on manufacturers own stock. Particularly for day to day office printers you could save a lot if you chose compatibles instead.



Use the 'draft' setting - When you go to print, you get to choose the quality. If the document is for internal use, think about using the 'draft' setting which uses significantly less ink than the standard or high quality settings.
